

DRAFT CONSTITUTION

1- NAME

The name of this organization shall be

2- PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to aid and benefit, by mutual cooperation, the art of amateur radio with particular emphasis on mobile operations.

To promote social activities among the members and their families.

To promote discussions on technical subjects ~~and~~ improve and maintain the mobile activities on a high standard.

To cooperate and assist Civil authorities to the fullest extent possible in any emergency.

3- MEETINGS

Meetings shall be held as directed in the By-Laws.

4- Amendments

The constitution may be amended by a 75% affirmative vote of the membership, provided that due notice of the change is given.

BY-LAWS

1- Membership shall be divided into three classes;

a) Full member, open to all radio amateurs having mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.

b) Associate member, open to all radio amateurs irrespective of equipment.

c) Novice member, open to anyone having interest in amateur radio.

2-Dues for members and associate members shall be \$2.50 annually, and for Novice members \$1.00 annually.

3- Applications for membership must be approved by the executive, and meet certain requirements as detailed in the rules.

BY LAWS (con't)

4- The annual meeting of the club will be held during the second week of January for the election of the ~~Directors~~ ^{Executive Body} and the transaction of other business.

5- Meetings shall also be held at such other times and places as the directors or officers shall decide.

5- One third of the membership of the club or if one third be less than nine, then nine persons shall constitute a quorum for the transactions of the business at all meetings of the club.

6- A full member and associate member shall be entitled to one vote.

7- The executive body shall consist of five persons namely

Vice President
Secretary
Technical Advisor
Group Activities

whose duties shall be to carry on the activities of the club.
